RULES FOR SNOWPLOWING 2015-2016 WINTER

1. A Contract with the Town of Goodman must be signed and dated by the owner or occupant giving the Town permission to enter upon his/her property.
2. All Contracts are to be postmarked on or before November 5th of each year. The owner or occupant must also pay the Town of Goodman the sum \$125.00/private and \$145.00/business before said date. Contracts postmarked after this date will be assessed a late fee of \$25.00. **NO CONTRACTS OR FEES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER December 1st**
3. There will be no special trips. When the snowplows go out, they do all roads first, then all paid driveways with a minimum of 3 to 4 inch snowfall (Town discretion). Permanent residents have first priority of being plowed, unless prior notice is given.
4. The Town reserves the right to refuse snowplowing on any driveway it deems in such condition as to render it unsuitable for its equipment. The town will not be liable for damage to driveways (gravel or blacktop), lawns and yards.
5. No driveways will be plowed unless there is a 12 foot clearance from overhead obstructions such as trees, wires, etc.
6. Plowing of driveways is not to interfere with snow removal from roads and streets as determined by the town board.
7. Early Fall and late Spring snowplowing will be at the discretion of Town Board and Town Crew.
